Iowa Law requires that every child under the age of 13 wear an appropriately sized life vest at all times when on a recreational vessel.

Anyone being towed by a vessel must also wear a life vest.

Size **DOES** matter! Follow the maximum capacity of your boat!



The boat has a maximum passenger count for a reason. No, the boat probably won't sink if there is one extra child onboard, BUT... it could roll over on its side if weight is poorly distributed. Then you will all very quickly be in the water in a panic.

DON'T OVERLOAD THE BOAT!

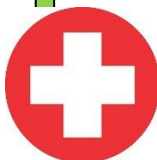
SOMEONE FALLS OVERBOARD
